

Kitten Vaccinations and Health Routine

Age	Treatment
8 Weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Physical Examination • Feline Distemper Vaccine – 1st booster in 2 booster series. • Feline Leukemia Vaccine – 1st booster in 2 booster series. • Dewormer
12 Weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Physical Examination • Feline Distemper Vaccine – 2nd and final booster in 2 booster series. • Feline Leukemia Vaccine – 2nd and final booster in 2 booster series. • Dewormer
16 Weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Physical Examination • Rabies Vaccine • Dewormer
6-8 Months	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spay/Neuter Recommended • Microchipping recommended at time of spay/neuter surgery. • Declawing – Laser procedure available for indoor cats.
1 Year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Annual Physical Examination • Rabies Vaccine – Annual booster *will be eligible for 3 year booster if updated within the month of the due date* • Feline Distemper Vaccine – Annual booster. • Feline Leukemia Vaccine – Annual booster. • Possible dewormer (depending on your pet)
